Outline

1. What does a Life Group do?

- a. Devotes itself to:
 - i. The apostle's teaching (in this case the pastor's)
 1. Questions from church office on Sunday AM Message
 - ii. Fellowship
 1. Getting to know each other...
 - iii. Sharing in meals
 1. Coordinating the meal
 - iv. Prayer
 1. Prayer for each other and the church
 2. Prayer for the group until you next meet

2. Who leads a Life Group?

- a. Made of one or two people/couples who are gifted in hosting and/or leadership
- b. Hosting
 - i. Making the sure meeting location is clean, food is ready, seating is ready, people are comfortable, and people feel welcome.
- c. Leading
 - i. Staying on schedule
 - ii. Moderating questions (but not preaching)
 - iii. Making sure people pray between groups (this can also be a position)

3. Life Group Covenant

- a. Everyone who is not "just visiting" signs

4. When does a Life Group end?

- a. It is recommended that it never meets for much more than 1 and a half hours (people will hesitate to come on full days knowing they won't leave)
